School Access Route Plan

Spring Canyon Middle School 2023-24

In accordance with state standards, Spring Canyon Middle School has identified school access routes for School students who <u>live within the walk boundary established for the school</u>. A map showing the identified routes can be viewed by following the link below. (Insert a link or give other instruction on how to access the map)

The intent of a School Access Route Plan is <u>not</u> to identify every school access route or to identify the more convenient school access routes; it is to identify main walk/bike routes that appear to be secure. Care has been taken to consult with local law enforcement, school PTA and School Community Council representatives, and the District's traffic safety committee in establishing these school access routes. Despite broad consultation and unanimous agreement from all parties involved in establishing these routes, no one, including the Nebo School District and Sage Creek School can guarantee that the agreed upon school access routes are or will ever be completely free from hazards.

Parents are encouraged to walk or bike the school access routes with their child/children, to address specific concerns they may have, and to instruct their child/children to obey the laws and rules pertaining to pedestrian safety. If a parent feels their child/children should use a school access route that <u>is not</u> identified in this plan, it is their prerogative to instruct their child/children as to what they feel is best for them.

As previously stated, the intent of a School Access Route Plan is <u>not</u> to identify every school access route or to identify the more convenient school access routes. For this plan, school access routes leading to the school from areas where clusters of students live, have been identified and are described below.

School Access Route Description:

*Please note that each written description area corresponds to the map – for example, area 1 noted on the map has a written description for area 1 indicated on the map.

Area 1: Students living between 1200 W and 1500 W, south of 1300 S.

Students should make their way to the intersection of 1300 S and Archmore Dr. At this intersection, students should use the crosswalks at that intersection to reach the north side of 1300 S where they should walk east to 1200 W, then south to 1325 S. Continue walking along 1325 S (which turns into Matteo Lane) to 700 S, turn east on 700 S and proceed toward the school.

Area 2: Students living between 1200 W and 1500 W, north of 1300 S

Students should walk to 1300 S, walk east on the north side of 1300 S until they reach 1200 W. Students should cross to the east side of 1200 W, walk south to 1325 S where they will turn east on 1325 S. (Note - students will be tempted to cross at 1150 S, but there is no

intersection marked at this intersection as of Apr 2021.) Continue walking along 1325 S (which turns into Matteo Lane) to 700 S, turn east on 700 S and proceed toward the school.

Area 3: Students living east of 1200 W and south of 1325 S.

Students should walk to 1325 S (via 1425 S if needed) where they should follow 1325 S. Continue walking along 1325 S (which turns into Matteo Lane) to 700 S, turn east on 700 S and proceed toward the school.

Area 4: Students living east of 1200 W and between 1325 S and 1150 S.

Students should proceed east on the street they live on until they reach 950 W. Once on 950 W, students should proceed north to 1150 S and then east on 1150 S until they reach 750 W (also called Matteo Dr.) Students should proceed north on Matteo Dr to 700 S then turn east on 700 S and proceed toward the school.

Area 5: Students living east of 1200 W and between 1150 S and 800 S.

Students should proceed east on the street they live on until they reach 950 W. Once on 950 W, students should proceed north or south (depending on street) to 900 S and then east on 900 S until they reach 750 W (also called Matteo Dr.) Students should proceed south on Matteo Dr to 700 S then turn east on 700 S and proceed toward the school.

Area 6: Students living east of 950 W and south of 900 S.

Students should proceed either east or west from their house (depending on street) to 750 W (also called Matteo Dr.) Students should proceed south on Matteo Dr to 700 S and proceed towards the school. Alternatively, students can turn from Matteo Dr east on 800 S, north on 665 W towards the school.

Area 7: Students living directly on 750 W (also called Matteo Dr.), either side of the road, or east of 750 W between 900 S and 700 S.

Students living directly on 750 W (also called Matteo Dr.) should proceed north or south (depending on street) to 800 S. Students living east of Matteo Dr. should proceed west to Matteo Dr and either north or south (depending on street) to 800 S where they should proceed east to 655 W. Once on 665 W, students should proceed north on 665 W towards the school.

Area 8: Students living north of 700 S between 950 W and 400 W.

Students should proceed south on the street they live on towards 700 S. Students can use 800 W, 850 W, 750 W, 575 W, or 525 W to get to 700 S. Once on 700 S, proceed east or west (depending on which street you use) to get to the intersection of 700 S and 725 W. Students should cross at the intersection to get on the south of 700 S and proceed east towards the school. *Note: students will be tempted to cross 700 S in the middle of the street, but should proceed to 750 W to cross at the intersection and marked crosswalk.

Area 9: Students living between 400 W and Highway 89 and south of 400 S (near Springville City Cemetery).

Students should proceed north from their street to 400 S taking care to stay on the south side of 400 S. Once on 400 S, students should proceed west until they reach 750 W where they should turn south. Proceed along 750 W to 700 S, then east on 700 S towards the school.
